Benefits	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● If international students who graduated from Japanese universities cannot start a business within 6 months, they can apply for "Designated Activities" visa for additional 6 months (18 months for those who graduated from designated universities*), utilizing the measures by the Japanese Government indicated in the far-right column.</li> <li>● Assistance by SME management consultants are available in preparation for business plans.</li> <li>● Income deduction is available.</li> <li>● Interest subsidies are available.</li> <li>● For maximum of 1 year from the initial extension of status of visa, applicants are permitted to conduct a business in the coworking space registered by the Aichi Prefectural Government.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● If international students who graduated from designated universities* cannot start a business within 1 year, they can apply for "Designated Activities" visa for an additional year, utilizing the measures by the Japanese Government indicated in the far-right column.</li> <li>● If you are unable to start a business within one year, you may apply for a " Business Manager " visa for another six months using the system on the far left.</li> <li>● Assistance by SME management consultants are available in preparation for business plans.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Applicants may apply for a change of status of residence from "Student" to "Designated Activities" with certificates from universities.</li> <li>● Assistance by university staff is available in preparation for business plans.</li> </ul>
